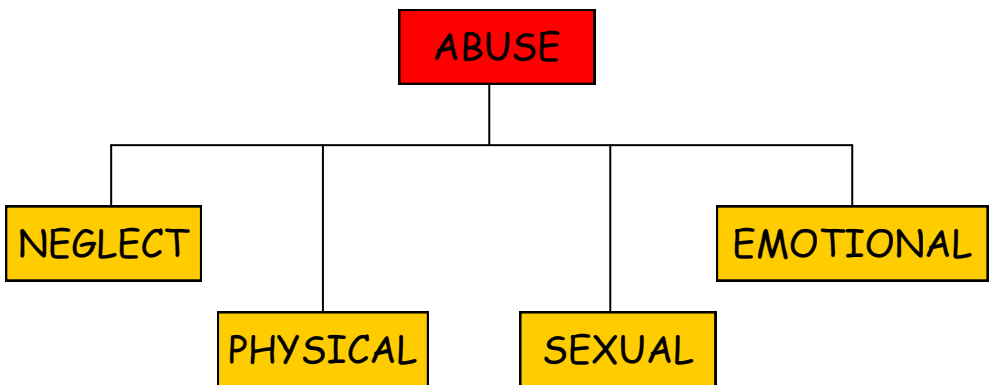

Who has a duty to safeguard children?

EVERYONE!

We all have a duty to safeguard children, which includes looked after and vulnerable children.

We need to safeguard children from:



Our duty of care is to report incidents of concern to appropriate agencies.

There are opportunities to look at the needs of children through multi-agency meetings.

We have a rigorous and robust recruitment process that gathers evidence about staff suitability to work with children and all references are checked. All staff, students, governors and volunteers must undergo an enhanced police check.



All staff and volunteers undertake regular Safeguarding training.

We are required to keep a log of any existing injuries which include explanations from adults and children.



Any allegations made against staff will be dealt with through Rotherham Safeguarding Children Board. If allegations involve Daycare staff it will also be reported to OFSTED.
